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Teva UK Limited Bursary Scheme

Guidelines for Applicants and their referee

Teva UK Limited is committed to the continued study of Pharmacy. Teva is therefore pleased to be able to conditionally offer a limited number of student bursaries for those students studying towards a degree level qualification in Pharmacology or a similar subject.

The bursary scheme is intended to help students who would otherwise suffer hardship. This might mean financial hardship or the need for help with caring for a relative. This bursary is open to any home UK student either already attending, or who has been offered a place on, any full time UK-based undergraduate course approved by a School or Pharmacy or similar. We especially welcome applications from A-Level students.

To be considered, applicants must normally be able to provide evidence that they have in the last academic year claimed education maintenance allowance (EMA) or carers allowance. Applications from students who have not claimed these benefits in the last year may be accepted in exceptional circumstances e.g. home circumstances have changed, death of parent etc. Written evidence of receipt of these benefits, or the exceptional circumstances, must be included with this application.

Through the bursary programme, Teva aims to

- provide assistance to those students who would otherwise suffer hardship whilst studying for a degree level qualification
- encourage successful applicants to continue the study of Pharmacology with a view to considering a role in the pharmaceutical industry

The bursary is worth a total of £1,500 over the course of the degree (for up to three years) and will be paid in £500 installments for each academic year, on receipt of evidence that you have recommenced studies.

Your personal statement

In addition to completing the Personal Details and Education sections of the application form, you should provide a Personal Statement of approximately 300 words. This is your opportunity to tell us why you want to study Pharmacology and why you have a particular interest in this area. Any other matters that might have a bearing on your academic studies, which you would wish to bring to the attention of the Bursary Selection Panel, may also be provided here e.g. how this bursary might influence your decision to study Pharmacology and your personal circumstances.

Please use only the space provided. *No additional pages will be accepted.*



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Your referee's statement

This application includes a reference form which you should hand to your current 6th form tutor for completion. In doing so, you consent to the tutor providing a reference for use in the selection procedure. Your tutor should return the reference directly to HR Shared Services at Teva UK Limited.

It will be the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that this reference is supplied to Teva.

The Selection Panel

The Bursary Selection Panel will comprise of HR Managers within Teva UK Limited. The Panel's decision is final.

Throughout your degree

You must remain on the degree program associated with the bursary award. If you change to another program you will be required to return the bursary monies for the academic year in which the transfer takes place.

Throughout your degree you will need to demonstrate a continued satisfactory level of performance and meet the social & ethical standards required of an undergraduate student for payments to continue, failure to meet these academic and behavioral standards could result in the removal of the bursary in the following academic year.

Data Protection Act
